

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at YWAM Lord's Land. Your contribution to our ministry is valuable and appreciated. Let us tell you a little bit about what we have in mind.

No one at the Lord's Land receives a salary or remuneration of any kind. We are all either long term missionaries or short term volunteers. We can offer you a place to stay while you are working with us but you'll have to provide your own food. Your first two weeks with us will be a trial period during which we both (you and us) can evaluate whether we are right for each other at this time. From that time we will consider you a short term volunteer. Ordinarily, volunteers work with us for up to 3 months. Those who feel called to be part of our ministry on a long term basis, should join Youth With A Mission as staff. The first step in this process is to attend a Discipleship Training School (DTS). We will be offering one here in September of 2009.

Our typical work week is from 9:00 to 5:00, Monday through Friday. We begin each work day with prayer at 8:00. We all pitch in to do whatever needs to be done. We clean cabins for guests, we maintain our 28 acre property, do laundry, chop firewood, unclog drains....As we have the skills and materials available, we try to do some needed upgrades on the cabins.

We are also increasingly involved in ministry in the community. We run occasional weekend encounters for high school students here at the Lord's Land. We also have other seminars that we offer through the Spring and Summer months. Every Tuesday evening, we host a community meeting. Believers (and a few seekers) from various Churches come here for a potluck, teaching, and worship. We generally have around 40 in attendance.

We encourage every member of our community to attend a local Church on a weekly basis. We will also pair you up with a staff person who can offer spiritual support and accountability.
